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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Macon County; to amend Section 2 of Act
4 93-875 of the 1993 First Special Session (Acts 1993 First
5 Special Session, p. 137), as last amended by Act 2008-463 of
6 the 2008 Regular Session (Acts 2008, p. 900), relating to the
7 Macon County Economic Development Authority; to provide for a
8 voting member of the board of directors to be appointed by
9 Tuskegee University.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 2 of Act 93-875 of the 1993 First
12 Special Session (Acts 1993 First Special Session, p. 137), as
13 last amended by Act 2008-463 of the 2008 Regular Session (Acts
14 2008, p. 900), is amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 2. The authority shall be governed by a
16 board of directors consisting of members to be appointed as
17 follows: One member appointed by the Macon County Commission;
18 one member appointed by the member of the Alabama House of
19 Representatives who represents Macon County; one member
20 appointed by the member of the Alabama State Senate who
21 represents Macon County; one member appointed by Tuskegee
22 University; and one member appointed by the governing body of
23 each incorporated municipality in the county. The initial
24 terms of the directors shall be staggered. Two members, the
25 one appointed by the member of the House of Representatives

1 representing Macon County and the one appointed by the member
2 of the Alabama Senate representing Macon County, shall serve
3 for initial terms of two years and the remaining members shall
4 serve for initial terms of one year each. Notwithstanding the
5 foregoing, the initial member added to the board by
6 appointment of a municipality that did not appoint a member
7 prior to the effective date of the act adding this language
8 shall serve a term of four years and the initial member
9 appointed by Tuskegee University shall serve a term of four
10 years. Any member serving on the effective date of the act
11 adding this language, except the member previously appointed
12 by Tuskegee University, shall serve the remainder of his or
13 her term. Thereafter, all members shall serve for a term of
14 four years. All members shall serve until their successors are
15 appointed and qualified and no member shall serve for more
16 than two consecutive full terms. Upon a vacancy, the successor
17 shall be appointed in the same manner and by the same method
18 as the member whose place is being filled.

19 "Within 30 days after the effective date of this
20 act, the appointing authorities shall submit the names and
21 addresses of the members of the board to the judge of probate
22 and the appointments shall be filed and maintained in the
23 office of the judge of probate. The members shall elect from
24 among themselves a president, vice-president, secretary, and
25 treasurer. Each officer shall serve for a period of one year

1 or until a successor is elected to serve. No officer shall be
2 bonded, except the treasurer, who shall obtain bond as an
3 official.

4 "Ex officio nonvoting members of the board shall
5 consist of: One member from each industrial development board,
6 one member appointed by the Macon County Chamber of Commerce,
7 and one member from the Macon County Board of Education. The
8 board shall meet at least once per month."

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
10 first day of the third month following its passage and
11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
