ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Colbert County; to amend Act 2009-367 of the 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 692), now appearing as Section 45-17-80.02, Code of Alabama 1975, providing additional court costs in domestic violence cases in the circuit, district, and municipal courts; to further provide for distribution of the funds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2009-367 of the 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 692), now appearing as Section 45-17-80.02, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-17-80.02.

"In addition to all other costs and charges in circuit, district, and municipal court cases in Colbert County, there shall be levied and assessed a court cost of twenty-five dollars (\$25) in all cases in which court costs are assessed which are determined by the judge to be domestic violence cases. The clerk of ~~the~~ each court shall collect the court costs and shall remit the proceeds ~~quarterly~~ monthly to ~~the Office of the Chief Presiding District Court Judge of Colbert County to be distributed~~ Alabama Coalition Against Domestic Violence after the deduction of one dollar (\$1) of the twenty-five dollars (\$25) fee in each case. The Alabama

1 Coalition Against Domestic Violence shall distribute the
2 proceeds to domestic violence programs operating in Colbert
3 County that are in compliance with the standards for operation
4 of the Alabama Coalition Against Domestic Violence."

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
6 first day of the third month following its passage and
7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
