8 Relating to public K-12 education; to require local
9 boards of education to have available feminine hygiene
10 products in certain schools at no cost to students.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the 2022-2023
13 scholastic year, each local board of education shall have
14 available, in each school building under the jurisdiction of
15 the board, where any student in grades five through 12 is
16 enrolled, at the request of a student for personal use and at
17 no cost to students, feminine hygiene products.

18 (b) For the purposes of this section, feminine
19 hygiene products are sanitary napkins and tampons.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
