ENROLLED, An Act,

To amend Section 16-64-2, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the requirements for determining student residency, to also classify certain members of the Alabama National Guard as residents who are eligible for instate tuition rates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 16-64-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§16-64-2.

"For purposes of admission and tuition, a public institution of higher education may consider that the term resident student includes any of the following:

"(1) One who, at the time of registration, is not a minor and satisfies one of the following:

"a. Is a full-time permanent employee of the institution at which the student is registering or is the spouse of such an employee.

"b. Can verify full-time permanent employment within the State of Alabama or is the spouse of such an employee and will commence said employment within 90 days of registration with the institution.

1            "c. Is a member or the spouse of a member of the  
2 United States military on full-time active duty stationed in  
3 Alabama under orders for duties other than attending school.

4            "d. Is employed as a graduate assistant or fellow by  
5 the institution at which the student is registering.

6            "e. Is an accredited member of or the spouse of an  
7 accredited member of a consular staff assigned to duties in  
8 Alabama.

9            "f. Is, at the time of passage of this chapter, a  
10 student enrolled at a public college or university and who is  
11 currently classified as a resident for tuition purposes  
12 provided such student maintains continuous enrollment at that  
13 institution.

14            "g. Commencing on the effective date of the act  
15 adding this paragraph, is a member of the Alabama National  
16 Guard. adding this paragraph, has been a member of the Alabama  
17 National Guard for a period of at least two years immediately  
18 preceding the student qualifying for resident tuition and  
19 continues to be a member of the Alabama National Guard while  
20 enrolled at the public institution of higher education.

21            "(2) One who, at the time of registration, is a  
22 minor and whose supporting person satisfies one of the  
23 following:

24            "a. Is a full-time permanent employee of the  
25 institution at which the student is registering.

1            "b. Can verify full-time permanent employment within  
2 the State of Alabama and will commence said employment within  
3 90 days of registration with the institution.

4            "c. Is a member of the United States military on  
5 full-time active duty stationed in Alabama under orders for  
6 duties other than attending school.

7            "d. Is an accredited member of a consular staff  
8 assigned to duties in Alabama."

9            Section 2. This act shall become effective  
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
