NAMING THE TUSKEGEE SYPHILIS STUDY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

IN MACON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, to recognize a part of history contributed to by some of the African American citizens in the Tuskegee area, we name a portion of Highway 81 in Macon County the Tuskegee Syphilis Study Memorial Highway; and

WHEREAS, in 1932, a study was initiated in Tuskegee, Alabama, that was known for its unethical considerations and inhumane treatment of the participants; that study ended in 1972, 25 years after the cure for syphilis was known and publicly available; and

WHEREAS, the study was later considered an unethical experiment that provided information regarding subjects who were intentionally denied treatment; among other things, the study participants were not provided an opportunity for informed consent, were subjected to unnecessary dangers, and were coerced into agreeing to autopsies; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that more than 100 participants died as a result of this disreputable study; and it is fitting to honor the memory of the participants in the Tuskegee Syphilis Study; now therefore,
