12 year old and then transitioned into the Girl Scouts of the
13 USA; she asked for permission to build and install a Little
14 Free Library at the Fowl River Community House and now keeps
15 it stocked with books for all to use; and

16 WHEREAS, while in the Girl Scouts, she started to
17 find her voice in advocating for accessibility in the camps
18 and outings she attended; she began a service project sewing
19 pillowcases for the patients at USA Health Children's and
20 Women's Hospital where she is a frequent patient, as she was
21 born with Spina Bifida and has had many surgeries and
22 hospital stays; she now heads up that part of the mission
23 with the nonprofit Krewe of Kindness and calls the
24 pillowcases Krewe Cases; and

25 WHEREAS, Delaney has continued to work hard to keep
26 her head high, but it has not been easy; she bravely tried
27 out for the Mobile Belle Leadership program and while she
28 did not make it the first time, she tried again the

29 following year and has been a docent at the Richards-DAR
30 home during her senior year; she is also a volunteer with
31 the Red Shoe Krewe at the Ronald McDonald House in Mobile;
32 she worked with the hospital on a teen advisory council
33 before Covid, and she will be volunteering with them this
34 summer; and

35 WHEREAS, Delaney has homeschooled her entire life and
36 completed her coursework through the ACCESS virtual learning
37 program; it has allowed her to not only stay on task with
38 her studies at any time of day or night, but also to be
39 available to participate in community activities; now
