8 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF HIGHWAY 20 FROM WATERLOO
9 ROAD TO COX CREEK PARKWAY, STEWART CINK HIGHWAY.

11 WHEREAS, with great pride and adulation, the Alabama
12 Legislature hereby recognizes Stewart Cink, 2009 British Open
13 Champion, and desires to commemorate his fine accomplishments
14 and dedication to serving the needs of others by naming a
15 highway in his honor; and

16 WHEREAS, a former resident of Florence, Alabama, Mr.
17 Cink defeated the sentimental favorite by six shots in a tense
18 four-hole playoff to win the 138th British Open Championship
19 at Turnberry, Scotland, on July 19, 2009; his proud fans in
20 Alabama include his parents, Anne and Rob Cink, and his former
21 teacher who predicted his greatness, Chris Burns; and

22 WHEREAS, in addition to his international acclaim as
23 a professional golfer, Mr. Cink is widely respected for his
24 commitment to family, community service, and worthy causes; he
25 and his wife, Lisa, return home to North Alabama every year to
26 host The Healing Place Charity Championship to benefit The

1 Healing Place, a safe haven for grieving and hurting children;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, in order to commemorate in an enduring
4 manner his international acclaim as a golfer and his
5 dedication to serving the needs of the Alabama community in
6 which he received his start in his career; now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Highway 20 from Waterloo Road
9 to Cox Creek Parkway is hereby designated Stewart Cink
10 Highway; appropriate authorities are encouraged to erect and
11 maintain signs and markers specifying this designation of
12 honor.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
14 resolution be provided to Stewart Cink and the Department of
15 Transportation, so that this meritorious designation is known.
