WHEREAS, the 50 clubs and 1,200 members located in communities throughout the State of Alabama develop outstanding programs and projects to address common issues and concerns; some of the areas addressed through programs and projects include access to and support of the arts, education and libraries, natural resources preservation, support of veterans, public and individual health and wellness, child advocacy, and citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of scholarships and libraries have been major focus areas for GFWC Alabama and local clubs; GFWC Alabama has been actively involved in the GFWC Signature Program, Domestic and Sexual Violence Awareness and Prevention; and
