1 2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 143 BETWEEN 3 MILE MARKERS 5 AND 6 IN MILLBROOK, ALABAMA, IN MEMORY OF 4 5 OFFICER JAMES FEZATTE. 6 WHEREAS, Officer James Fezatte was a City of 7 8 Millbrook Police Department Officer; and WHEREAS, Officer Fezatte served his country for over 9 10 20 years as a member of the United States Air Force and fought 11 in the Gulf War; and 12 WHEREAS, on March 28, 2007, Officer Fezatte was 13 killed in a vehicle crash after responding to a civil 14 disturbance call at approximately 1050 hours; and 15 WHEREAS, Officer Fezatte was survived by his wife, 16 Cyndi Fezatte, and his two sons, Austin and Travis Fezatte; 17 and 18 WHEREAS, it is most fitting that the Legislature 19 memorialize the portion of Alabama Highway 143 between Mile Markers 5 and 6 in Millbrook, Alabama, to honor Officer 20 21 Fezatte; now therefore, 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of Alabama Highway 143 between Mile Markers 5 and 6 in Millbrook, Alabama, is 24 25 designated the "Officer James Fezatte Memorial Highway."

10	signage should also incorporate the official emblem of the		
11	United States Air Force and the official emblem of the		
12	Millbrook Police Department, provided all rights to		
13	incorporate such aforementioned military emblems are granted		
14	by the United States Air Force, or other such grantee of the		
15	United States Department of Defense and the Millbrook Police

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be presented to the wife, children, mother, and brothers and sisters of Officer James Fezatte, as named above so that they may know of the esteem in which we hold their fallen husband and father, and the service he made to his country, his state, and the City of Millbrook.
