WHEREAS, she attended Lewis Adams School on Tuskegee University's Campus; while she was a student there, First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt visited on March 31, 1941, and had lunch with her and the other children; and

1 WHEREAS, Elnora married David McNeil, Jr., on June
2 8, 1950; she and her husband reared nine children, Thelma,
3 Gwendolyn, Arlenda, Pamela, Keith, Brenda, Kenneth, Ramona,
4 and Melissa; she has 20 grandchildren, 39 great-grandchildren,
5 and one great-great-grandchild; and

6 WHEREAS, Elnora's great-grandfather, Richard Wheat,
7 was among the first African American men in 1867 to vote in
8 Alabama; her other great-grandfather, Ed Whitlow, was in the
9 Syphilis Study, also known as the Tuskegee Experiment; and

10 WHEREAS, for over 20 years, she worked at the
11 Veterans Hospital and at the Lincoln Drive-In in Tuskegee
12 where she was known as the friendly face at the snack bar; and

13 WHEREAS, Elnora Pugh McNeil is a very loving wife
14 and mother, as well as a friend to many; it is an honor to
15 recognize and celebrate her on her special day; now therefore,
