11	WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates that
12	40,610 women in the United States will die from breast cancer
13	in 2017; about 650 of those women will be in Alabama;
14	approximately 440 men from Alabama will die from breast cancer
15	in 2017; and
16	WHEREAS, approximately 252,710 new cases of invasive
17	breast cancer will be diagnosed in women and 2,740 cases in
18	men in the United States before the end of 2017; and about
19	3,960 of those cases will occur in women in Alabama; and
20	WHEREAS, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness
21	Month; detection of breast cancer at an early stage greatly
22	improves the chances for successful treatment and survival;
23	early detection programs and notification laws contribute to
24	the early detection of breast cancer; and
25	WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature passed Act 2013-284
26	requiring a physician to provide specific notification to a
27	woman when a mammogram indicates that she has dense breast

tissue; dense breast tissue makes it more difficult to locate cancer on a mammogram and is associated with an increased risk of breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, notification of dense breast tissue is accompanied with encouragement for a woman to be more vigilant in her care, including in testing, screening, and seeking other options for identifying the presence of breast cancer; the notification increases the doctor/patient relationship and is credited with saving lives; and

WHEREAS, indeed, awareness and early detection efforts provide ways in which countless individuals can increase success in battling breast cancer; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That it is with highest commendation that we recognize October 2017 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month, and, by copy of this resolution express our support regarding early detection and notification of dense breast tissue in the battle against breast cancer.
