8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF REVEREND LUTHER EYER KRAMER,
9 III.

11 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow and regret that
12 news is received of the death of Reverend Luther Eyer Kramer,
13 III, of Hampton Cove, Alabama, on December 26, 2009, at the
14 age of 67; and

15 WHEREAS, Reverend Kramer was a retired ordained
16 minister of the North Alabama Presbytery; he attended Big Cove
17 Presbyterian Church and was founder and director of The Key -
18 North Alabama Center for Pastoral Counseling; he was a
19 Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist and a Licensed
20 Professional Counselor and was highly regarded for his
21 dedication and skills; and

22 WHEREAS, his educational background included earning
23 a Bachelor's Degree from Florida State University and a Master
24 of Divinity Degree from Columbia Theological Seminary; he also
25 attended Harvard Law School's Program for Lawyers in Mediation
26 and Negotiation as well as completing all requirements except

1 dissertation in the Forest Institute of Professional
2 Psychology's Doctoral Program in Clinical Psychology; and

3 WHEREAS, a leader in community affairs, Reverend
4 Kramer had been active in the Huntsville Rotary Club since
5 1991, serving as president in 2000-2001; he had served five
6 years on the Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling; in
7 addition, he was a member of the Huntsville Hospital Ethics
8 Board and a longtime supporter of the Huntsville Symphony and
9 Young Life; and

10 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death a daughter,
11 Meredith Kramer Hay; son-in-law, John C. Hay, III; three
12 grandchildren; and a cousin, Mary Anne Kramer; and

13 WHEREAS, Reverend Kramer was a valued member of the
14 community whose presence will be greatly missed by all those
15 who were privileged to know him; now therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
17 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Reverend Luther
18 Eyer Kramer, III, is recorded with deep sadness, and this
19 resolution is offered in tribute to his life, along with
20 heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
