35 Missionary Association (PAMA), which has grown into a large
36 mission organization that works to transform the lives and
37 people around the Continent of Africa; PAMA has conducted
38 many conferences and seminars in major cities and nations of
39 Africa; God has used His servant Johnny Johnson and PAMA to
40 restore lives and help numerous people throughout Africa;

42 WHEREAS, Johnny has, through the help of Aslan Child
43 Rescue Ministries, established a nongovernmental
44 organization (NGO) in Nigeria that in partnership with PAMA
45 has awarded partial scholarships to 45 orphaned and
46 destitute children; has worked and helped over 2000 widows
47 throughout Eastern Nigeria; has helped disabled persons in
48 the Abia State of Nigeria; has helped to improve the lives
49 of the poor people in Nigeria and Benin Republic; and during
50 the Covid-19 pandemic, helped many Muslims with food supply;
