5	INTERIM TASK FORCE IN JEFFERSON COUNTY.
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7	WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the State of
8	Alabama to provide the finest quality of modern health care
9	services possible to its citizens; now therefore,
10	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
11	THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Cooper Green and Health
12	Care Service Interim Task Force in Jefferson County is hereby
13	created. The task force shall be composed of the following
14	members:
15	(1) The Alabama House of Representatives Jefferson
16	County delegation chair shall appoint eight members.
17	(2) The Director of Cooper Green.
18	(3) The Jefferson County Health Department
19	administrator
20	(4) The President of the Jefferson County
21	Commission.
22	(5) The County Commission Chair of the Health and
23	Community Services Committee.
24	The task force may utilize any and all available
25	expertise and resources of governmental academic, financial,
26	educational, or legal organizations in conducting its
27	business.

The task force shall hold its first meeting as instructed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The chair of the task force shall be the member or his or her successor from District 55 and the co-chair shall be the Director of Cooper Green Hospital. The vice chair shall serve as acting chair in the absence or incapacity of the chair. The task force shall meet at times and locations as specified by a call of the chair or upon a vote of four or more task force members. The task force shall study all aspects of adequacy of earmarks, services rendered, performance, and compare those aspects with federally funded clinics in Mobile County.

Upon the request of the chair, the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the task force. The task force shall report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature no later than the fifth legislative day of the 2012 Regular Session, whereupon the task force shall stand dissolved and discharged of any further duties and liabilities.

Each legislative member of the task force shall be entitled to his or her regular legislative compensation, his or her per diem, and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the task force, which shall be paid upon requisitions signed by the chair of the task force out of any funds appropriated to the use of the Legislature by means of warrants drawn by the Comptroller on the State Treasury.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, no legislative member shall

receive additional compensation or per diem for a meeting day 1 2 of the task force when he or she attends a regular or special legislative session meeting day or legislative task force 3 meeting day, or if a member is being paid any other payments on the same date for attendance on other state business. 6 Members of the task force who are state or county officials, 7 other than legislative members, shall receive no compensation for their service on the task force, but may be reimbursed for 8 expenses from funds appropriated to or otherwise available to 9 10 their respective departments. The total expenditures of the

task force shall not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
