15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
16	Section 1. Section 31-2-13, Code of Alabama 1975, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	"§31-2-13.
19	"(a) Military leave of absence All officers and
20	employees of the State of Alabama, or of any county,
21	municipality, or other agency or political subdivision
22	thereof, or officers or employees of any public or private
23	business or industry who are active members of the Alabama
24	National Guard, Naval Militia, the Alabama State Guard
25	organized in lieu of the National Guard, <u>the National Disaster</u>
26	Medical System, or of any other reserve component of the armed
27	forces uniformed services of the United States, shall be

1 entitled to military leave of absence from their respective 2 civil duties and occupations on all days that they are engaged in field or coast defense or other training or on other 3 4 service ordered under the National Defense Act, the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act 5 6 of 2002, or of the federal laws governing the United States 7 reserves, without loss of pay, time, efficiency rating, annual vacation, or sick leave. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no 8 9 person granted a leave of absence with pay shall be paid for 10 more than 168 working hours per calendar year, and those persons shall be entitled, in addition thereto, to be paid for 11 12 no more than 168 working hours at any one time while called by 13 the Governor to duty in the active service of the state. This 14 section shall apply to all schools and institutions of 15 learning supported by state funds.

"(b) Credit for active federal service. - Service in 16 17 the National Guard or Naval Militia of Alabama, when called, drafted, or ordered into the service of the United States, 18 shall be considered as equivalent service in the Alabama 19 National Guard or Naval Militia for any and all state purposes 20 21 regarding privileges, honors, pay, allowances, and exemptions 22 provided by law for members of the National Guard and Naval Militia of Alabama." 23

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 25 first day of the third month following its passage and 26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
