3 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
4 existence and functioning of the Alabama Board of Cosmetology
5 and Barbering until October 1, 2028.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
8 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama
9 Board of Cosmetology and Barbering until October 1, 2028.

10 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama
11 Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, created and functioning
12 pursuant to Chapter 7B of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, is
13 continued, and those code sections are expressly preserved.

14 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
15 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
16 Sections 1 and 2.

17 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
18 2024.
