4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to COVID-19 vaccinations; to provide that a
6 minor may not receive a COVID-19 vaccine without parental
7 consent; to prohibit an institution of education from
8 inquiring about a minor student's vaccination status without
9 parental consent; and to provide for enforcement by the
10 Attorney General.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, the terms
13 "vaccination" and "vaccine" mean any injection intended to
14 prevent the spread of COVID-19 or minimize the effects of
15 COVID-19, irrespective of whether or not the injection meets
16 the classical definition of vaccine.

17 (b) Notwithstanding Section 22-8-4, Code of Alabama
18 1975, no minor may receive a vaccination without the written
19 consent of the minor's parent or, if applicable, legal
20 guardian.

21 (c) Institutions of education may not inquire into
22 the vaccination status of a minor student without the written
23 consent of the minor's parent or, if applicable, the legal
24 guardian.

1 (d) The Attorney General may commence a civil action
2 to enjoin a threatened or continuing violation of this
3 section.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
