8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, an inmate who is
9 assigned to drive a motor vehicle is not required
10 to be insured pursuant to the Mandatory Liability
11 Insurance Act.

12 This bill would require the custodian of
13 each inmate who is assigned to operate a motor
14 vehicle on the public roads or streets within this
15 state to insure the inmate pursuant to the
16 Mandatory Liability Insurance Act.

22 Relating to inmates; to provide that the custodian
23 of each inmate assigned to operate a motor vehicle on the
24 public roads or streets within this state shall insure the
25 inmate pursuant to the Mandatory Liability Insurance Act.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the
2 custodian of each inmate who is assigned to operate a motor
3 vehicle on the public roads or streets within this state shall
4 provide the inmate with liability insurance pursuant to the
5 Mandatory Liability Insurance Act.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
