26	Relating to courts; to provide for additional
27	circuit judgeships in various judicial circuits throughout the

state; to provide for additional district judgeships in various counties throughout the state; and to provide for the authority of the judges and for the compensation and benefit of the judges.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) (1) There is created an additional circuit judgeship for the Fifth Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeship Number 4.

- (2) There is created an additional circuit judgeship for the Sixth Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeship Number 7.
- (3) There is created an additional circuit judgeship for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeship Number 4.
- (4) There are created two additional circuit judgeships for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeships Number 12 and 13.
- (5) There are created two additional circuit judgeships for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeships Number 4 and 5. The judges appointed or elected to Judgeships Number 4 and 5 may reside in any county within the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.
- (6) There are created three additional circuit judgeships for the Twenty-third Judicial Circuit which shall be designated as Circuit Judgeships Number 8, 9, and 10.

- (e) The annual compensation of the additional circuit judges appointed or elected pursuant to subsection (a) shall be in accordance with Chapter 10A of Title 12, Code of Alabama 1975, including, but not limited to, the provision that no circuit judge first appointed or elected to office after October 1, 2001, shall be provided a salary supplement or expense allowance.

  - (2) There is created an additional district judgeship in the District Court of Cullman County which shall be designated as District Judgeship Number 3.
  - (3) There is created an additional district judgeship in the District Court of DeKalb County which shall be designated as District Judgeship Number 2.
  - (4) There is created an additional district judgeship in the District Court of Etowah County which shall be designated as District Judgeship Number 3.
  - (5) There is created an additional district judgeship in the District Court of Madison County which shall be designated as District Judgeship Number 5.

- (e) The annual compensation of the additional district judges appointed or elected pursuant to subsection

(a) shall be in accordance with Chapter 10A of Title 12, Code 1 2 of Alabama 1975, including, but not limited to, the provision 3 that no district judge first appointed or elected to office after October 1, 2001, shall be provided a salary supplement 4 5 or expense allowance. Section 3. This act shall become effective January 6 1, 2023, following its passage and approval by the Governor, 7 or its otherwise becoming law. 8
