#### SYNOPSIS:

This bill would authorize any county, municipality, or governmental entity subject to a countywide civil service system to elect by a majority vote of the governing body to opt out of the countywide civil service system.

This bill would also require the county, municipality, or governmental entity to adopt a human resources policy and procedures manual and to provide written notification to the director of the countywide civil service system.

To authorize any county, municipality, or governmental entity subject to a countywide civil service system to elect by a majority vote of the county or municipal governing body to opt out of the countywide civil service system; to require the county, municipality, or governmental entity to adopt a human resources policy and procedures manual; and to require the county, municipality, or governmental entity to notify the director of the countywide civil service system of its decision to withdraw from the system.



- 29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 30 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
- 31 term "countywide civil service system" means a civil service
- 32 system established by a general or local law that applies to a
- 33 county and any municipality in the county.
- 34 (b) Any county, municipality, or governmental entity
- 35 subject to a countywide civil service system by majority vote
- of the county commission, city, or town council or the
- 37 governing body of the governmental entity may elect to
- 38 withdraw from a countywide civil service system
- 39 notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 40 whether in a general or local law. If any county,

55 effective date of the withdrawal, shall adopt a human 56 resources policy and procedures manual, which shall include 57 personnel policy guidelines; operational standards; employee 58 management, recruitment, hiring, and due process termination 59 procedures; equal employment opportunities policies; grievance 60 resolution procedures; and workplace harassment policies. The 61 policies and procedures adopted by the county, municipality, 62 or governmental entity under this subsection shall include an 63 independent appeal and review process to consider employee terminations, suspensions, and demotions, and may also include 64 65 a merit system for employees. The policies and procedures adopted by the county, municipality, or governmental entity 66 shall ensure that its existing employees continue to enjoy any 67 68 employment rights, interest, or privileges that are vested or 69 vesting under the applicable countywide civil service system rules as of the effective date of the withdrawal. After 70 71 withdrawal, all required employment due process procedures, 72 outlined in the county, municipality, or governmental entity's 73 human resources policy and procedures manual shall govern 74 future employees. 75 Section 2. (a) (1) All current employees of any county, 76 municipality, or governmental entity making the election 77 authorized by Section 1(b) to withdraw from a countywide civil 78 service system shall remain eligible to participate in any 79 pension plan or other retirement benefit plan if that current 80 employee was eligible to participate in this plan before the 81 date of withdrawal.



(2) Any future employees of any county, municipality, or governmental entity making the election authorized by Section 1(b) to withdraw from a countywide civil service system shall be eligible to participate in any pension plan or retirement benefit plan if that future employee would have been eligible to participate before the effective date of withdrawal by virtue of his or her employment with the county, municipality, or governmental entity. 

- (3) Any current or future employee of any county, municipality, or governmental entity affected by this act that was previously eligible or would have been eligible for and subject to mandatory membership in any pension plan or other retirement benefit plan by virtue of being a member of the classified service in the county, municipality, or governmental entity before the effective date of the withdrawal shall remain subject to mandatory membership in that pension plan or other retirement benefit plan.
- (4) Any eligibility determinations for any benefits previously made by reference to information provided by a county civil service system shall be made by reference to information furnished by the county, municipality, or governmental entity employing the employee.

shall not affect the service credit for pension benefits or other retirement benefits for any employee of the county, municipality, or governmental entity. Any employee who is a member of a pension plan or other retirement benefits plan or eligible to be a member of a pension plan or other retirement benefits plan shall have prior and future service credited for pension benefit purposes as though the withdrawal had not occurred. The withdrawal of any county, municipality, or governmental entity from any countywide civil service system shall not be deemed a break in service for pension benefit service crediting purposes or a termination of employment for distribution purposes.

(c) In the event a county, municipality, or governmental entity exercises their rights under Section 1(b) to withdraw from any countywide civil service system, any appointing authority exercised by the countywide civil service system on any county pension board, retirement benefit plan, or other government retirement system shall revert to the respective county, municipality, or governmental entity that sponsors the pension plan, retirement benefit plan, or other government retirement system. Nothing in this subsection, however, shall apply if the withdrawing county, municipality, or other governmental entity participates in any retirement system administered by the State of Alabama.



130	(d) This section shall apply notwithstanding any specific
131	provision or section of any prior act or provision of law to

133	Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately
