1 SB206

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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama
6 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted
7 during the 2009 First Special Session and the 2010 Regular
8 Session as contained in the 2010 Cumulative Supplement to
9 certain volumes of the code and 2010 Replacement Volumes 7A,
10 17A, 18, and 18A; to adopt and incorporate into the Code of
11 Alabama 1975, 2010 Cumulative Supplements to local law
12 volumes; and to specify that this adoption and incorporation
13 constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire
14 Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a
15 code; to declare that the Code Publisher has certified it has
16 discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes; to
17 expressly provide that this act does not affect any other 2010
18 Special Session statutes or 2011 session statutes; and to
19 specify the duties of the Secretary of State regarding the
20 custody of these cumulative supplements and replacement
21 volumes.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. Those general and permanent laws of the
24 state enacted during the 2009 First Special Session and the
25 2010 Regular Session as contained in the 2010 Cumulative

1 Supplements to Volumes 3 to 7, inclusive, and Volumes 8 to 17,
2 inclusive, Volume 17B, and Volumes 19 to 22A, inclusive, and
3 the 2010 Replacement Volumes 7A, 17A, 18, and 18A and the
4 additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner for
5 editorial purposes, as edited and published by West Group, as
6 the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2010 Cumulative
7 Supplement and 2010 Replacement Volumes are identified and
8 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed
9 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the
10 cumulative supplement and upon the first inside page and the
11 last inside page of the replacement volume, are adopted and
12 incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

13 Section 2. The local and permanent laws pertaining
14 to various counties enacted during the 2009 First Special
15 Session and the 2010 Regular Session as contained in the 2010
16 Cumulative Supplement to Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, and 22E and
17 the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner for
18 editorial purposes, as edited and published by West Group, as
19 the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2010 Cumulative
20 Supplement are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal
21 of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each
22 of the volumes of the cumulative supplement, are adopted and
23 incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

24 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
25 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act

1 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the
2 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the
3 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
4 as amended. This act is a law that adopts a code for the
5 purposes of Section 45 of the Official Recompilation of the
6 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

7 Section 4. It is declared that West Group, as the
8 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its
9 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2010
10 Replacement Volumes 7A, 17A, 18, and 18A of the Code of
11 Alabama 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound
12 volumes with the material contained in the cumulative
13 supplement without making substantive changes, but making,
14 under the supervision and pursuant to the direction of the
15 Code Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as
16 may have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes
17 of names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and
18 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and
19 misspellings.

20 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not
21 repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any
22 statute enacted into law during any 2010 Special Session and
23 any 2011 session of the Legislature.

24 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act,
25 the duly authenticated volumes of the 2010 Cumulative

1 Supplements and the 2010 Replacement Volumes shall be
2 transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the
3 volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that
4 office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes
5 shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of
6 State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper
7 certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or
8 parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for
9 similar services.

10 Section 7. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
