18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. Section 8-8-10, Code of Alabama 1975, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	<b>"</b> §8-8-10.
22	"(a) Judgments for the payment of money, other than
23	costs, if based upon a contract action, bear interest from the
24	day of the cause of action, at the same rate of interest as
25	stated in said the contract; all other judgments shall bear
26	interest at the rate of $\frac{12}{7.5}$ percent per annum, the
27	provisions of Section 8-8-1 to the contrary notwithstanding;

1	provided, that fees allowed a trustee, executor,
2	administrator, or attorney and taxed as a part of the cost of
3	the proceeding shall bear interest at a like rate from the day
4	of entry.
5	"(b) This section shall apply to all judgments
6	entered on and after the effective date of the act adding this
7	subsection."
8	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
9	first day of the third month following its passage and
10	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
