5 To make a supplemental appropriation from the State
6 General Fund to the Department of Corrections in the amount of
7 \$52,475,875 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; and
8 a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to
9 the Alabama Medicaid Agency in the amount of \$41,995,706 for
10 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; and a supplemental
11 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Department of
12 Public Health in the amount of \$100,000 for the fiscal year
13 ending September 30, 2010 for an ALS clinic; and a
14 supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the
15 Department of Environmental Management in the amount of
16 \$385,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 for the
17 Pollution Control Grant Fund; and a supplemental appropriation
18 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Supreme Court for
19 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of
20 \$110,000; and a supplemental appropriation from the State
21 General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Industries
22 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of
23 \$227,000; and a supplemental appropriation from the State
24 General Fund to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal
25 year ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of \$2,000,000;

1 and a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund
2 to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for
3 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of
4 \$350,000 for Alabama Black Belt Adventures; and a supplemental
5 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Department of
6 Veterans' Affairs in the amount of \$56,400 for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 2010 for veterans' programs; and a
8 supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the
9 Geological Survey in the amount of \$325,000 for a ground water
10 assessment project for the fiscal year ending September 30,
11 2010; and a supplemental appropriation from the State General
12 Fund to the Court of Criminal Appeals for the fiscal year
13 ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of \$130,000; and a
14 supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the
15 Alabama Historical Commission for the fiscal year ending
16 September 30, 2010 in the amount of \$10,000 for historical
17 markers; and a supplemental appropriation from the State
18 General Fund to the Tourism Department for the fiscal year
19 ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of \$650,000 for
20 tourism projects; and a supplemental appropriation from the
21 State General Fund to the Legislative Building Authority for
22 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 in the amount of
23 \$150,000; and a supplemental appropriation of an amount up to
24 \$82,000,000 from the Mental Health Capital Improvement Account
25 to the Department of Mental Health for capital outlay and

1 other expenditures for the fiscal year ending September 30,
2 2010; and a supplemental appropriation of \$1,750,000 to the
3 Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute from the
4 Recruitment and Training Promotion Fund for the fiscal year
5 ending September 30, 2010; and a supplemental appropriation of
6 \$250,000 to the Department of Revenue from the Recruitment and
7 Training Promotion Fund for the fiscal year ending September
8 30, 2010; and a supplemental appropriation of \$155,000 to the
9 Veterinary Medical Examiners Board from the Veterinary Medical
10 Examiners Board Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30,
11 2010; and a supplemental appropriation of \$50,000 to the
12 Securities Regulatory Board from the Security Certification
13 Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; and a
14 supplemental appropriation of \$120,000 to the Department of
15 Insurance from the Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity
16 Standards and Firefighter Protection Act Fund for the fiscal
17 year ending September 30, 2010.

18 To also amend the fiscal year 2010 General
19 Appropriation Bill (Act 2009-550) by: (1) changing the funding
20 source on the General Obligation Bonds, 1999 Series B, and on
21 the General Obligation Parks Bonds, Series 2001-C, from the
22 Capital Improvement Trust Fund to the State General Fund; (2)
23 further providing for distribution of Community Services
24 Grants funds in Fiscal Year 2010; and (3) providing further

1 for a transfer of vaccine funds from the Department of
2 Corrections to the Department of Public Health.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$52,475,875 from the State General Fund to the Department of
7 Corrections for operational costs for the fiscal year ending
8 September 30, 2010.

9 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
11 \$41,995,706 from the State General Fund to the Alabama
12 Medicaid Agency for operational costs for the fiscal year
13 ending September 30, 2010.

14 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$100,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of
17 Public Health for the Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
18 Association of Alabama for the establishment of an ALS
19 Regional Certified Clinic for the fiscal year ending September
20 30, 2010.

21 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
23 \$385,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of
24 Environmental Management for the Pollution Control Grant Fund
25 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

1 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
3 \$110,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Supreme
4 Court for operational costs for the fiscal year ending
5 September 30, 2010.

6 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
8 \$227,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of
9 Agriculture and Industries for the fiscal year ending
10 September 30, 2010.

11 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
13 \$2,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Unified Judicial
14 System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

15 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
17 \$350,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of
18 Conservation and Natural Resources for the fiscal year ending
19 September 30, 2010 for the Alabama Black Belt Adventures.

20 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations
21 heretofore or hereafter made there is hereby appropriated
22 \$56,400 from the State General Fund to the Department of
23 Veterans' Affairs for the fiscal year ending September 30,
24 2010 for the following veterans programs in the following
25 amounts: (1) \$50,000 for the Disabled American Veterans

1 organization, and (2) \$6,400 for the Congressional Medal of
2 Honor meeting.

3 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$325,000 from the State General Fund to the Geological Survey
6 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, which shall be
7 expended for a statewide ground water assessment project and
8 to consult with researchers at Alabama A&M University in their
9 ground water assessment project.

10 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations
11 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
12 \$130,000 from the State General Fund to the Court of Criminal
13 Appeals for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

14 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$10,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Historical
17 Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 for
18 the purchase of historical markers.

19 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$650,000 from the State General Fund to the Tourism Department
22 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 for the
23 following purposes in the following amounts: (1) \$400,000 for
24 the Greater Birmingham Convention and Visitors Bureau for the
25 Indy Grand Prix of Alabama; (2) \$200,000 for operations and

1 maintenance at the Department of Tourism and Travel; (3)
2 \$25,000 for the F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald Museum; and (4)
3 \$25,000 for the Roxie Theater.

4 Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$150,000 from the State General Fund to the Legislative
7 Building Authority for the fiscal year ending September 30,
8 2010 for the purpose of ensuring sufficient space and
9 facilities for the functions of the Legislature.

10 Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations,
11 there is hereby appropriated an amount up to \$82,000,000 from
12 the Mental Health Capital Improvement Account to the
13 Department of Mental Health for capital outlay and other
14 expenditures for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

15 Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations,
16 there is hereby appropriated \$1,750,000 to the Alabama
17 Construction Recruitment Institute from the Recruitment and
18 Training Promotion Fund, pursuant to Act 09-561, for the
19 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

20 Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations,
21 there is hereby appropriated \$250,000 to the Department of
22 Revenue from the Recruitment and Training Promotion Fund for
23 the costs of administration and collection of revenues for the
24 Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute pursuant to Act
25 09-561, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

1 Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations,
 2 there is hereby appropriated \$155,000 to the Veterinary
 3 Medical Examiners Board from the Veterinary Medical Examiners
 4 Board Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for
 5 the one-time expenses of moving the administration offices of
 6 the Board from Decatur to Montgomery.

7 Section 19. In addition to all other appropriations,
 8 there is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Security
 9 Certification Fund to the Securities Regulatory Board for the
 10 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, pursuant to Act 09-640.

11 Section 20. In addition to all other appropriations,
 12 there is hereby appropriated \$120,000 from the Reduced
 13 Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standards and Firefighter
 14 Protection Act Fund to the Department of Insurance for the
 15 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, pursuant to Act 09-630.

16 Section 21. Subsection 40 of Section 2C of Act
 17 2009-550 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 Section 22. The reverted and re-appropriated amount
2 of State General Fund Community Services Grants provided for
3 in Section 3 of the FY 2010 General Appropriation bill (Act
4 2009-550) shall be treated separately from the FY 2010 General
5 Fund appropriation to the State Executive Commission on
6 Community Services Grants for purposes of calculating the FY
7 2010 statutory formula allowed to each member of the House. It
8 is the intent of this language that each member receives at
9 least his or her statutory share of the Community Services
10 Grants appropriations over the two year period.

11 Section 23. From the appropriations made in the FY
12 2010 General Fund Appropriation bill (Act 2009-550), there is
13 hereby transferred on the effective date of this act from the
14 Department of Corrections, the amount of unexpended funds
15 earmarked for Hepatitis A and B vaccines to the Department of
16 Public Health for the department's hepatitis vaccination
17 program.

18 Section 24. In addition to all other appropriations
19 and requirements heretofore and hereafter made for the fiscal
20 year ending September 30, 2010, no employee furloughs,
21 involuntary reductions in work force, or layoffs may occur in
22 any departments, agencies, boards, and commissions funded in
23 whole or part from the State General Fund budget.

1 Section 25. This act shall become effective
2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
3 upon its otherwise becoming law.
