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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide a cost-of-living
9 increase for state employees of 10 percent, over a
10 two fiscal year period, for a five percent increase
11 for fiscal year 2013-2014, and a five percent
12 increase for fiscal year 2014-2015.

15 TO BE ENTITLED
16 AN ACT

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18 To provide a cost-of-living increase for state
19 employees for the fiscal years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. Beginning with the first payday on
22 October 1, 2013, all state employees who are listed in the
23 classified and unclassified service of the state as defined in
24 Section 36-26-10, Code of Alabama 1975, and all other state
25 employees and hourly employees of the state, except those set
26 out in Section 2, and all legislative personnel, officers, and
27 employees, including, but not limited to, Legislative

1 Reference Service personnel, whether subject to the state
2 Merit System or not, and all employees of the county health
3 departments who are employed subject to the state Merit System
4 and whose compensation is paid out of a budget provided and
5 agreed upon by the state, county, or other contributing agency
6 under the direction of the State Board of Health shall receive
7 a five percent cost-of-living salary increase for each of the
8 fiscal years 2013-2014, and 2014-2015.

9 Section 2. (a) Any cost-of-living increase granted
10 under this act shall in no way apply to any local supplement
11 provided to any judges or to any other local employee whose
12 salary is tied to that of any state employee.

13 (b) This act shall not apply to any Merit System
14 employee or hourly employee whose service or rate of pay is
15 covered by any labor agreement or contract.

16 Section 3. The Director of the State Personnel
17 Department shall revise the schedule of rates set forth in the
18 pay plan for state employees and shall send the same to the
19 state Comptroller, who shall issue warrants in accordance
20 therewith. With respect to all court officials and employees
21 within the Unified Judicial System who serve the trial and
22 appellate courts of the state and the Administrative Office of
23 Courts, the Administrative Director of Courts shall revise the
24 schedule of rates set forth in the pay plan for these court
25 officials and employees to reflect the increase provided in
26 this act, and shall certify the same to the state Comptroller,
27 who shall issue warrants in accordance therewith. With respect

1 to employees of the Legislature, the Secretary of the Senate
2 for employees of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of
3 Representatives for employees of the House, the Director of
4 Legislative Reference Service for employees of the Legislative
5 Reference Service, and the Director of Legislative Fiscal
6 Office for employees of the Legislative Fiscal Office shall
7 revise the schedule of rates set forth in the pay plan for
8 their employees to reflect the increase provided in this act
9 and shall certify the same to the state Comptroller, who shall
10 issue warrants in accordance therewith.

11 Section 4. It is not the intent of this act to make
12 appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act
13 shall be made in the annual budget act for the affected
14 entities.

15 Section 5. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
