4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
6 existence and functioning of the State Pilotage Commission
7 until October 1, 2020, with certain modifications; to amend
8 Section 33-4-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize the
9 Governor to appoint an advisory member to the commission.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
12 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State
13 Pilotage Commission until October 1, 2020, with the additional
14 recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

15 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
16 State Pilotage Commission, created and functioning pursuant to
17 Sections 33-4-1 to 33-4-57, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975,
18 is continued until October 1, 2020, and those code sections
19 are expressly preserved.

20 Section 3. Section 33-4-1 of the Code of Alabama
21 1975, is amended to read as follows:

22 "§33-4-1.

23 "(a) There shall be a board of pilotage
24 commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission,
25 which shall consist of three voting members, ~~one to~~ One

1 voting member shall be an official of a steamship company
2 which maintains an office in Mobile, one ~~to~~ voting member
3 shall be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by ~~such~~
4 the State Pilotage Commission, and one ~~to~~ voting member shall
5 be a business ~~man~~ person or a person engaged in a professional
6 occupation licensed by the State of Alabama.

7 "(b) An additional member, who shall serve in a
8 nonvoting advisory capacity, may be appointed to the
9 commission by the Governor from a list of nominations by the
10 Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority. Any provision of
11 Section 33-4-3 to the contrary notwithstanding, the advisory
12 commissioner shall serve without reimbursement for expenses
13 incurred on behalf of the commission and shall submit no
14 commissioner's fees.

15 "(c) The membership of the commission shall be
16 inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,
17 urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state.

18 "(d) The ~~Such~~ State Pilotage Commission shall have
19 ~~such~~ the powers and duties as are prescribed in this chapter
20 and as may hereafter be prescribed by law.

21 "(e) A quorum for the transaction of commission
22 business shall be two voting members of the commission."

23 Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
24 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
25 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

1 Section 5. This act shall become effective
2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
3 its otherwise becoming law.
