8 SYNOPSIS: Currently, the Constitution of Alabama of  
9 1901, provides that no person may be elected or  
10 appointed to a judicial office after reaching the  
11 age of 70 years.

12 This bill would provide that a person who is  
13 not over the age of 72 when qualifying for election  
14 and a person who is not over the age of 72 at the  
15 time of appointment may be appointed to the office  
16 of Judge of Probate of Henry County and may be  
17 elected to the office of Judge of Probate of Henry  
18 County.
