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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide for the issuance of
9 a distinctive Alabama State Nurses Association
10 license plate. This bill would provide for the
11 design of the distinctive plate.

12 This bill would provide that any motor
13 vehicle owner who is a resident of the state could
14 receive the distinctive motor vehicle plate upon
15 payment of an additional fee of \$50. This bill
16 would provide for distribution of the additional
17 fee to the Alabama State Nurses Association.

23 To provide for the issuance of a distinctive Alabama
24 State Nurses Association license plate; to provide for an
25 additional fee for the license plate; to provide for the
26 design of the plate; and to provide for the distribution of
27 the proceeds of the additional fee.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 32-6-64,
3 32-6-67, and 32-6-68, upon application to the judge of probate
4 or license commissioner, compliance with motor vehicle
5 registration and licensing laws, payment of regular fees
6 required by law for license plates for private passenger or
7 pleasure motor vehicles, and payment of an additional annual
8 fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of motor vehicles who are
9 residents of Alabama shall be issued distinctive Alabama State
10 Nurses Association license plates.

11 (b) These plates shall be valid for five years, and
12 may then be replaced with either conventional, personalized,
13 or new Alabama State Nurses Association license plates.

14 (c) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
15 the years during which a new plate is not issued shall be
16 evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama
17 1975.

18 (d) Officials from the Alabama State Nurses
19 Association shall design, or have designed, the plate, which
20 design shall be approved by the Department of Revenue. Section
21 32-6-5, Code of Alabama 1975, shall not apply to the plates
22 designed pursuant to this section.

23 (e) The plates shall be issued, printed, and
24 processed like other distinctive and personalized plates
25 provided for in this chapter.

1 (f) The additional revenues derived from the sales
2 of the distinctive motor vehicle license plates shall be
3 distributed to the Alabama State Nurses Association.

4 Section 2. This act shall not become operative as to
5 license plate applications until January 1, 2015, or as
6 otherwise provided by rule of the department.

7 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
8 first day of the third month following its passage and
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
