The advisory board shall 14 elect one from its membership to serve as chair for a two-year 15 term. The chair shall not serve consecutive terms.

4 "(d) Each ex officio member's term will shall be indefinite. In the case of vacancy, the new appointee shall 5 6 serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any vacancy 7 shall be filled by the original organization selecting said the member. Members of the advisory board shall serve without 8 compensation but shall be entitled to reimbursement for 9 10 expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of their 11 office as provided in Article 2, commencing with Section 12 36-7-20, of Chapter 7 of Title 36 of this code.

"(e) With the consent of the majority of the members of the advisory board, the chair shall set requirements for proxy representation, voting, and the establishment of a quorum."

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 18 first day of the third month following its passage and 19 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
