1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Any active and contributing member of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Employees' Retirement 3 4 System who has 10 years or more of credible service in either system may claim and purchase service credit in the system for 5 prior service for employment as an employee with the United 6 7 States Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency if the employment occurred between August 1, 1987, and February 28, 8 1998, and if the member complies with the conditions 9 10 prescribed in subsection (b).

11 (b) Any member eligible to claim and purchase the 12 service credit pursuant to subsection (a) shall be awarded credible service with the Teachers' Retirement System or 13 14 Employees' Retirement System on the basis of one twelfth of a 15 year for each month or portion of month of employment service 16 only if the member pays into the retirement system or fund 17 prior to the date of retirement of the member and prior to October 1, 2012, a sum equal to the full actuarially 18 determined cost for each year, or a portion thereof, of 19 service credit, as determined by the system's actuary. 20

(c) Proof of service and time of service shall be made by the member by affidavit with any supporting letter or other documentation submitted to the Teachers' Retirement System or Employees' Retirement System and, upon receipt thereof, the system shall promptly calculate the necessary contributions of the member and advise the member thereof.

1 Upon timely payment by the member, the service credit shall be 2 allowed the member.

3 (d) The provisions of this section shall terminate 4 on October 1, 2012, and no person shall be eligible to utilize 5 the options granted if not fully exercised and paid prior to 6 such date.

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
