9 WHEREAS, we note with great pride that a Trial Team
10 from Cumberland School of Law has won the Regional
11 Championship of the American Association of Justice (AAJ)
12 National Trial Association; and

13 WHEREAS, the AAJ competition included 224 teams,
14 divided into 14 regions comprised of 16 teams within each
15 region; and

16 WHEREAS, the winning Cumberland team was composed of
17 Timothy Douthit of Huntsville, Alabama; Shannon Cornman of
18 Knoxville, Tennessee; Megan Murren of Monroe, Georgia; and
19 Reanna Todd of Springfield, Tennessee; and coached by Mike
20 Rasmussen and Marc Jaskolka; they defeated a team from South
21 Texas College of Law in the semifinals and one from Baylor
22 University in the finals; and

23 WHEREAS, a separate Trial Team from Cumberland has
24 won a Regional Championship at the National Trial Competition;
25 Cumberland School of Law is distinguished as one of very few

1 schools to have won Regional Championships in both
2 competitions; now therefore,

4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we heartily congratulate the
5 Trial Team from Cumberland School of Law on winning the
