9 WHEREAS, commendations are extended to Mrs. Wanda

10 Jackson Robinson of Montgomery, Alabama, on the occasion of

11 her appointment as Director of the Mac Sim Butler Montgomery

12 County Detention Facility; and

13 WHEREAS, Wanda Robinson was promoted to the rank of

14 colonel and appointed as the director of the detention

15 facility on November 30, 2009; she became the first Black

16 female to hold either designation in the Montgomery County

17 Sheriff's Office, and prior to this promotion, served as the

18 first Black female major and Assistant Director of Detention

19 and the first Black female captain; and

20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Robinson provides administrative

21 leadership by supervising her subordinates, investigating and

22 resolving complaints, preparing and monitoring the facility's

23 budget, and by developing facility policies and procedures

24 that ensure the safety of the inmates and officers; in

1 addition, Mrs. Robinson acts as a liaison between the facility  
2 and the legal system; and

3 WHEREAS, Wanda Robinson, a native of Montgomery, is  
4 a graduate of Robert E. Lee High School and Alabama State  
5 University, with a Bachelor of Science Degree; she is the wife  
6 of Timothy D. Robinson, Sr., mother to one son, Timothy D.  
7 Robinson, Jr., and grandmother to Kalleal and Timothy Kavaris;  
8 she is also a lifelong member of Weeping Willow Baptist Church  
9 where she serves as a trustee; she is member of the Montgomery  
10 Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., which she  
11 currently serves as Chair of Program Outreach, and volunteers  
12 extensively; she is a dedicated member of the Montgomery  
13 County Sheriff's Office, where she volunteers in many of their  
14 community endeavors; and

15 WHEREAS, Wanda Robinson's achievements in the  
16 Montgomery County Sheriff's Office will stand as a legacy in  
17 the Black community and the Montgomery community as a whole;  
18 now therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
20 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Mrs. Wanda Jackson Robinson is  
21 highly commended upon her appointment as Director of the Mac  
22 Sim Butler Montgomery County Detention Facility, and by copy  
23 of this resolution, we honor her accomplishments.
