7 death on December 9, 2022, of Mrs. Patricia Camp "Patty"

32 Methodist Church; was a longtime member of the Old Elyton
33 Chapter of Daughters of the American Revolution and The

35 member of Little Club, Carousels, and Maskers Dance Club;
36 she was a golf enthusiast and played for many years at the
37 Country Club of Birmingham, Mountain Brook Club, Shoal
