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8 DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO INCLUDE SENATE
9 BILL 7, 2016 FIRST SPECIAL SESSION, RATIFYING CERTAIN BUDGET
10 ISOLATION RESOLUTIONS RELATING TO BILLS PROPOSING LOCAL LAWS,
11 ON THE 2016 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

13 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 7 of the 2016 First Special
14 Session, proposes an amendment to Amendment 448 to the
15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to "ratify, approve,
16 validate, and confirm the application of any budget isolation
17 resolution authorizing the consideration of a bill proposing a
18 local law adopted by the Legislature before November 8, 2016,
19 that conformed to the rules of either body of the Legislature
20 at the time it was adopted"; and

21 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 7 of the 2016 First Special
22 Session, proposes an amendment to Amendment 448 to the
23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to "ratify, approve,
24 validate, and confirm the application of any budget isolation
25 resolution authorizing the consideration of a bill proposing a
26 local law adopted by the Legislature before November 8, 2016,

1 that conformed to the rules of either body of the Legislature

3 WHEREAS, Section 284 of the Constitution of Alabama
4 of 1901, authorizes this body to propose amendments to the

13 WHEREAS, Section 1 of Senate Bill 7, as passed by
14 this body on August 25, 2016, specifies in part, that the
15 proposed constitutional amendment "shall become valid as a
16 part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified
17 electors voting thereon at the 2016 General Election"; now
18 therefore,

19 WHEREAS, Section 2 of Senate Bill 7, as passed by
20 this body on August 25, 2016, specifies in part, that the
21 proposed constitutional amendment "shall become valid as a
22 part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified
23 electors voting thereon at the 2016 General Election"; now
24 therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
26 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Secretary of State is
27 hereby directed to include Senate Bill 7 of the 2016 First

11 hereby directed to include Senate Bill 7 of the 2016 First
12 Special Session, proposing an amendment to Amendment 448 to
13 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, ratifying and confirming
14 the application of budget isolation resolutions authorizing
15 the consideration of a bill proposing a local law and adopted
16 by this body before November 8, 2016, on the 2016 General
17 Election ballot.
