1 Enrolled, An Act, 2 3 4 SJR OBSERVING JULY 20, 2024, AS NATIONAL SPACE 5 EXPLORATION DAY. 6 7 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has a long history with 8 space exploration and is proud to be the home of the titans of innovation who brought to the world the Saturn V rocket 9 and the world renowned Marshall Space Flight Center that 10 11 generates \$8.3 billion in economic impact and supports over 12 41,000 Alabama jobs; and 13 WHEREAS, on July 20, 1969, the world's attention was riveted on the historical achievement of the first man to 14 15 walk on the moon; and 16 WHEREAS, the United States National Space Policy 17 provides for a United States-led, integrated program with 18 commercial and international partners striving for a human return to the moon, followed by missions to Mars and beyond; 19 20 and 21 WHEREAS, the purpose of the United States Space 22 Program is, and has always been, the peaceful exploration of space for the benefit of all humanity; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the United States Space Program has provided 25 immense scientific and technological benefits affecting a

28 WHEREAS, the United States Space Program, through 29 otherworldly programs such as Apollo, Viking, Voyager, 30 Cassini-Huygens, Spirit, Opportunity, New Horizons, and 31 other missions to outer planets, the Space Shuttle, the 32 Hubble Space Telescope, the James Webb Space Telescope, the International Space Station, and other great space efforts, 33 has provided our nation with unparalleled scientific and 34 technological leadership in the space, aeronautics, medical, 35 36 and engineering sciences; and

37 WHEREAS, the same spirit of adventure and 38 engineering excellence that landed our Apollo space pioneers 39 on the moon may be applied to all noble pursuits involving 40 peace, brotherhood, courage, unity of human spirit, and the 41 exploration of new frontiers; and

42 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama and our nation 43 recognize the importance to mobilize and invigorate appreciation and enthusiasm for space; to advance science, 44 technology, engineering, and math (STEM) education through 45 46 the excitement of space exploration; and to inspire future generations to build upon the accomplishments of our early 47 space pioneers so they may reach new milestones of human 48 achievement; and 49
