8 URGING THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO  
9 ERECT EXIT SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAY 24 IN FRANKLIN COUNTY.

11 WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation  
12 has the authority to erect exit signs on interstates and  
13 expressways; and

14 WHEREAS, Alabama Highway 24 in Franklin County is a  
15 four lane divided highway with several rural interchanges but  
16 is not considered an interstate highway; and

17 WHEREAS, motorists would benefit from having exit  
18 signs erected along Highway 24 in Franklin County; now  
19 therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature urges the  
22 Alabama Department of Transportation to erect exit signs along  
23 Alabama Highway 24 in Franklin County at a distance of 1/4  
24 mile before each exit with special emphasis on the new 4-Lane  
25 Bypass in Red Bay, Alabama.
