8 WHEREAS, with an overwhelming sense of loss, we
9 receive news of the tragic death of Officer Steven Caserio
10 Dion Green, Mobile Police Department, on February 3, 2012, at
11 the age of 36 years; and

12 WHEREAS, the untimely but heroic death of Officer
13 Green leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, his
14 many friends, and the entire community; he was killed in the
15 line of duty while apprehending a robbery suspect; and

16 WHEREAS, born on February 25, 1975, in Mobile, he
17 was the son of Erica "Gussie" Hyter and Steve Lee Robinson and
18 was a member of Lily Missionary Baptist Church; he was a 1995
19 graduate of Blount High School, where he played varsity
20 football, and he later went on to coach Little League
21 Football; he will be remembered for his outstanding athletic
22 ability, the pride he took in his profession, and the love he
23 had for his family; and

24 WHEREAS, Officer Green joined the Mobile Police
25 Department on May 22, 2010, and worked as a recruit until his

1 Academy began in July 2010; on October 13, 2010, he started as
2 a trainee in 1st Precinct and was assigned to Squad 4, 5th
3 Precinct, on December 3, 2010; and

4 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his beloved
5 and loving wife, Valerie McQueen Green; three children,
6 Jasmine Green, Tariyan Green, and Steven Green, Jr.; a number
7 of additional devoted family members; the entire Mobile Police
8 Department; and numerous dear friends; and

9 WHEREAS, Officer Green personified the finest
10 qualities of those who dedicate their lives to serve and
11 protect their fellowman; although his presence will be greatly
12 missed, his legacy will endure and his memory will be
13 cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were fortunate
14 to know him during the brief span of his lifetime; now
15 therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
17 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the tragic yet heroic death of
18 Officer Steven Caserio Dion Green is recorded with deepest
19 sorrow, and this resolution is offered in highest tribute to
