8 news is received of the untimely death of Clinton Williams  
9 Taylor of Birmingham, Alabama, on February 15, 2010, at the  
10 age of 16 years; and

11 WHEREAS, in the death of this outstanding young man,

13 suffered an inconsolable loss; and

14 WHEREAS, Clinton was an honor student at Mountain  
15 Brook High School who planned to attend college after  
16 graduation; he was active in extracurricular organizations

19 Team and had traveled to several tournaments including the  
20 Wake Forest Tournament, where he won first place in the Junior  
21 Varsity Lincoln-Douglas Debate rounds; in addition, he was an  
22 Eagle Scout in Troop 28, where he had served in numerous  
23 leadership positions; and

24 WHEREAS, he sang in the Westminster Choir and was a  
25 faithful member of Independent Presbyterian Church, where he

1 was an acolyte and was active in the youth group, serving on  
2 the Youth Subcommittee and the Search Committee for the  
3 Assistant Youth Director; and

4 WHEREAS, he is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs.  
5 George M. Taylor, III; brother, George Malcolm Taylor, IV;  
6 sisters, Lottice Howell Taylor and Emma Bolling Hall Taylor;  
7 he is also survived by his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry C.  
8 Howell, Jr., and Mrs. George M. Taylor; and by Miss LuVenia  
9 Stewart; and

10 WHEREAS, Clinton's life was notable for his  
11 steadfast faith and loyalty to family and friends, as well as  
12 his sense of humor and enthusiasm for life; his presence will  
13 be greatly missed by those who were privileged to know him  
14 during the brief span of his years; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the untimely death of Clinton  
17 Williams Taylor is recorded with deep sadness, and this  
18 resolution is offered in highest tribute to his life, along  
19 with heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
