9 WHEREAS, it is a distinct privilege to extend
10 commendation to a highly accomplished Alabamian, Lieutenant
11 Governor Kay Ivey, on being selected to receive the 2016
12 American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA)
13 Public Service Award at the Awards Gala in Washington, D.C.,
14 on June 15, 2016; Lieutenant Governor Ivey is being honored
15 for her public service as a distinguished leader and stalwart
16 supporter of the aerospace industry and profession in Alabama

3 Creation and Military Stability Commission, which attracts
4 federal investments in Alabama; and she is a member of the
5 Alabama Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) Council that regulates
6 UAS activities in Alabama; and

7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor Ivey is an active
8 supporter of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics
9 (STEM) education, which helps students develop the necessary
10 skills to succeed in STEM job fields; she also supports the
11 U.S. Space and Rocket Center and Space Camp in Huntsville,
12 Alabama; and

13 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor Ivey is being
14 recognized for her work to promote the value of aerospace to
15 our nation's economy and competitiveness; she has demonstrated
16 how government can partner with academia and industry to
17 ensure a thriving aerospace sector and build a successful,
18 future workforce; and

19 WHEREAS, a native Alabamian, who brings immense
20 credit upon the entire State of Alabama, Lieutenant Governor
21 Ivey exemplifies the highest standards of professionalism,
22 superior initiative, and personal endeavors, and has earned
23 the respect and admiration of the people of the State of
24 Alabama and the nation; now therefore,
