36	36 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-26-310, co	ncerning certification of the	



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1	amount of property tax reduction resulting from the homestead property tax	
2	credit, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:	
3	(d) On or before January 30 each year, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the	
4	State shall submit a report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the	
5	Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate Committee	
6	on Revenue and Taxation, the members of the House Committee on Revenue and	
7	Taxation, the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the	
8	Secretary of State, the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the	
9	Commissioner of State Lands stating:	
10	(1) The balance of the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund;	
11	(2) Whether the fund could support an increase of the homestead

14	of the homestead property tax credit allowed under § 26-26-1118, the amount	
15	of increase that the fund could support.

17	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 26-26-1118(a)(1)(A), concerning the	
18	homestead property tax credit, is amended to read as follows:	
19	(a)(l)(A) There is established a homestead property tax credit for	
20	each assessment year that reduces the amount of real property taxes assessed	
21	on the homestead of each property owner by four hundred twenty-five dollars	
22	(\$425) <u>five hundred dollars (\$500)</u> .

24	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 2 of this act is effective for	
25	assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2024.	
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
