8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY
10 DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
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Subtitle

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13 AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 State Military Department the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 175 of 2015, for construction, major
26 maintenance, repairs, asphalt paving and associated expenses at various
27 National Guard Armories including, Warren, Mountain Home, West Memphis and an
28 Aviation Armory at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$188,629.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 175 of 2015, for the rehabilitation of National
31 Guard Armories throughout the State to ensure combat and State emergency
32 readiness, in a sum not to exceed.....\$118.

33 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 175 of 2015, for critically needed maintenance
35 for National Guard Armories state-wide for the State Military Department, in
36 a sum not to exceed.....\$123,632.



1 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 175 of 2015, for renovations to comply with ADA
3 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$106,424.

4 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction of the Camp
6 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,852,606.

7 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction and renovation
9 projects for ADA compliance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

10 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction and renovation of
12 a Youth Program Facility, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

13 (H) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 453 of 2015, for personal services, operating
15 expenses, materials, equipment, renovations, construction and maintenance
16 related to the administration of military justice in the Arkansas National
17 Guard, in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

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19 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby
20 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
21 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the
22 State Military Department the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction of the Camp
25 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,557,817.

26 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction and renovation of
28 Professional Education Center Dining Facility, in a sum not to exceed
29\$2,850,089.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction and renovation
32 projects for ADA compliance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

33 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction and renovation of
35 the Searcy Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,407,510.

36 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (E) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction of the Fort
2 Chaffee Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed
3\$5,187,100.

4 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (F) Section 2 of Act 216 of 2015, for construction of the Fort
6 Chaffee Sewer System, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,220,223.

7 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 175 of 2015, for construction of a Combined
9 Support Maintenance Shop at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed
10\$2,983,700.

11 (H) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 175 of 2015, for construction of the Searcy
13 Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,873,325.

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15 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS. There is hereby
16 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory
17 Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 175 of 2015, for repair, construction,
20 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other
21 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a
22 sum not to exceed.....\$2,384,185.

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24 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
25 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
26 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
27 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
28 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
29 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
30 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
31 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
32 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
33 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
34 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
35 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

36 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State

1 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
 2 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
 3 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
 4 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
 5 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
 6 otherwise by law.

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 8 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 17 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
