8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF  
10 HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

13 AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
14 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS NORTHEASTERN COLLEGE. There is  
21 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from  
22 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
23 Arkansas Northeastern College the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
25 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 207 of 2015, for construction, renovation,  
26 maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,  
27 technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to  
28 exceed.....\$175,000.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
30 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 207 of 2015, for construction, renovation,  
31 maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,  
32 technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to  
33 exceed.....\$250,000.

34 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
35 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 217 of 2015, for construction, renovation,  
36 maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,

36 Heber Springs Campus Academic Building, in a sum not to exceed

3 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - MID-SOUTH.

4 There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Mid-South,  
5 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
6 accounts, for the Arkansas State University - Mid-South the following:

 33 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 34 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
 35 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
2 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
3 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
4 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
5 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
6 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
7 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

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
