17 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING  
19 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act for Department of Justice Non-  
20 Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used for matching funds for  
21 administering the Federal Grants provided in this Act for the Department of  
22 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The Department of Finance and  
23 Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized to call  
24 upon all state agencies to assist in the implementation of the Department of  
25 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The funds appropriated in this Act for
