8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY
10 DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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13 AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
22 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the
23 State Military Department the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction and related
26 expenses for a Centralized Vehicle Wash Facility for cleaning heavy/tracked
27 vehicles, to provide vehicle maintenance for mechanized or tracked units and
28 related services, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,065,500.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of a Cabot Armory,
31 in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,549,822.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of a Combined
34 Support Maintenance Shop at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed
35\$31,210,072.

36 (D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of a Camden
2 Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,186,424.

3 (E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for renovations to comply with ADA
5 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

6 (F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Regional
8 Training Institute Phase II, in a sum not to exceed.....\$34,321,930.

9 (G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Searcy
11 Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,201,241.

12 (H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Fort
14 Chaffee Combined Army Collective Training Facility, in a sum not to exceed
15\$26,481,358.

16 (I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (K) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Fort
18 Chaffee Convoy Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed
19\$4,486,004.

20 (J) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
21 in Item (L) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction and renovation of
22 the CMTC (Chaffee Maneuver Training Center) Sewer Collection System, in a sum
23 not to exceed.....\$3,220,223.

24 (K) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (N) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Fort
26 Chaffee Infantry Platoon Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed
27\$3,926,000.

28 (L) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (O) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Fort
30 Chaffee Infantry Squad Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed
31\$6,166,000.

32 (M) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (P) Section 1 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction of the Convoy Live
34 Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,430,000.

35 (N) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction of the West

1 Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,524,075.

2 (O) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction of the Camp
4 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$12,066,000.

5 (P) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction of the Fort
7 Chaffee Operational Readiness Training Complex (ORTC), in a sum not to exceed
8\$40,072,863.

9 (Q) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 537 of 2011, for constuction and renovation of
11 the Camp Robinson Human Resources Office, in a sum not to exceed
12\$1,369,136.

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14 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is
15 hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
16 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
17 State Military Department the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 118 of 2011, for construction, major
20 maintenance, repairs, asphalt paving and associated expenses at various
21 National Guard Armories including, Warren, Mountain Home, West Memphis and an
22 Aviation Armory at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$383,788.

23 (B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 118 of 2011, for critically needed maintenance
25 for National Guard Armories state-wide for the State Military Department, in
26 a sum not to exceed.....\$123,632.

27 (C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 118 of 2011, for the rehabilitation of National
29 Guard Armories throughout the State to ensure combat and State emergency
30 readiness, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,791.

31 (D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 118 of 2011, for renovations to comply with ADA
33 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

34 (E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction of the West
36 Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,508,025.

1 (F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction of the Camp
3 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,022,000.

4 (G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 537 of 2011, for construction and renovation of
6 the Camp Robinson Human Resources Office, in a sum not to exceed
7\$456,379.

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9 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE. There is hereby
10 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory
11 Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 118 of 2011, for repair, construction,
14 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other
15 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a
16 sum not to exceed.....\$128,292.

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18 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
19 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
20 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
21 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
22 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
23 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
24 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
25 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
26 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
27 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
28 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
29 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

30 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
31 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
32 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
33 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
34 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
35 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
36 otherwise by law.

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2 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
3 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
4 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
5 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
6 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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11 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
12 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
13 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
15 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
17 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
18 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
21 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
