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13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
14 STATE POLICE REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be
22 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
23 accounts, for the Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 206 of 2015, for maintenance, renovation,
26 construction, equipping, improvement, upgrade, land acquisition and repairs,
27 in a sum not to exceed.....\$175,000.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for fleet vehicle purchase,
30 equipping and sales tax, in a sum not to exceed.....\$9,200,000.

31 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for construction of a new ASP Troop
33 L Headquarters in Lowell, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed
34\$10,818,100.

35 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for construction of a new ASP Troop



1 F Headquarters in Warren, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,196,600.

2 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for information technology
4 equipment, software, license, update, and enhancement, in a sum not to
5 exceed.....\$1,640,167.

6 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for construction of a centralized
8 evidence storage facility with security and inventory system to properly
9 identify and track all evidence, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,879,500.

10 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for the replacement of microwave
12 radio equipment installed on the Arkansas Wireless Information Network
13 (AWIN), in a sum not to exceed.....\$12,900,000.

14 (H) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for Lonoke County Tower replacement
16 and relocation, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,600,000.

17 (I) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for radio repeater infrastructure
19 replacement on the Arkansas Wireless Information Network, in a sum not to
20 exceed.....\$17,000,000.

21 (J) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for building and tower remediation
23 of the Arkansas Wireless Information System, in a sum not to
24 exceed.....\$1,500,000.

25 (K) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for hardware and software to track
27 radio system traffic of the AWIN User Management System, in a sum not to
28 exceed.....\$100,000.

29 (L) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (K) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for replacement of 700 MHz repeater
31 equipment and radios to be in compliance with FCC 700 MHz narrowbanding
32 mandate, in a sum not to exceed.....\$70,000,000.

33 (M) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (L) Section 1 of Act 816 of 2015, for the construction of new radio
35 repeater sites and critical infrastructure upgrades for the Arkansas Wireless
36 Information Network (AWIN), in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,500,000.

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SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund, for the Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 206 of 2015, for renovation of state owned property, in a sum not to exceed.....\$68,648.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE POLICE - TROOP L HEADQUARTERS.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund, for the Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 816 of 2015, for construction of a new ASP Troop L Headquarters in Lowell, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$875,000.

SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
