24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-121(a)(2), concerning the materials
27 and resources required for teaching African-American history in kindergarten
28 through grade twelve (K-12) in public schools, is amended to read as follows:

29 (2) Emphasis shall be placed on the historic work of American
30 and Arkansas civil rights leaders and events during the civil rights era,
31 including without limitation Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and his pursuit of
32 justice in civil society and John W. Walker.
