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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for the
26 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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26 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
 27 of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for the 2018-2019
 28 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 29 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 30 herein for such purposes: nineteen (19) temporary or part-time employees,
 31 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 32 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 33 appropriate classification.

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24 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

26 COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. Section 101(a)(7) of the

27 Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the

28 Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State

29 Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies to establish qualified personnel

30 standards for rehabilitation personnel, including VR counselors, that are

31 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification,

32 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order to

33 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is

34 hereby authorized for the Department of Career Education-Arkansas

35 Rehabilitation Services a general waiver of the Financial Management Guide,

36 R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional Education. This waiver allows the agency

1 to provide college level coursework in degree programs for any eligible
 2 employees selected by the agency. This provision covers any and all formula
 3 and discretionary grants funded by the U.S.D.O.E. Rehabilitation Services
 4 Administration, now or in the future, including, but not limited to, the
 5 Vocational Rehabilitation Program, Supported Employment, Independent Living,
 6 and the Staff Development Grant. The waiver applies to federal financial
 7 participation (FFP), state general revenue share, and program income.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, ~~2017~~ 2018
 9 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

10
 11 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

13 FORGIVENESS OF STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM. The Forgiveness of Student Loan Program
 14 shall be available to counselors employed by Arkansas Rehabilitation Services
 15 that have been determined eligible by rules promulgated by Arkansas
 16 Rehabilitation Services as required by Arkansas Code §25-30-206. These rules
 17 shall be submitted to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 18 Committee under § 10-3-309 and receive review and approval. These rules must
 19 include the following eligibility requirements:

20 (1) Satisfactory completion of any probationary period;

21 (2) Proof of a student loan that remains unpaid, including the name and
 22 address of the creditor;

23 (3) An executed employment contract in which the counselor agrees to
 24 the following:

25 (a) work for Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for a term that equals
 26 two (2) years for each year that the program makes a payment on the
 27 counselor's student loan and

28 (b) reimburse the program the full amount of any loan payments made
 29 under this program in the event that the counselor resigns or is terminated
 30 for cause before the term of the contract terminates.

31 The amount of payment to be made directly to the counselor's student
 32 loan creditor may not exceed:

33 (1) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year; or

34 (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per employee.

35 The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall pay for the
 36 Forgiveness of Student Loan Program from the Rehabilitation Program Grants -

1 Grants and Aid line item authorized for the appropriation entitled
2 Rehabilitation Services - Operations in an amount not to exceed eighty
3 thousand dollars (\$80,000) per fiscal year.

4 In addition, the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall provide a
5 formal, written notification to all counselors employed by Arkansas
6 Rehabilitation Services of the availability of the Forgiveness of Student
7 Loan Program by July 1 of each fiscal year. The agency shall include with the
8 notification, the promulgated rules which shall outline the eligibility
9 requirements for participation.

10 The agency shall submit a copy of this notification to the Arkansas
11 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee by July 1 of each fiscal year.
12 In addition, Arkansas Rehabilitation Services shall report bi-annually, by
13 the 15th day of the month following the end of each six month period, to the
14 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee the number of
15 employees participating in the program.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
17 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

18
19 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
20 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
22 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

28
29 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
30 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
31 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
32 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
33 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
34 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
35 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
36 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 14. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2018.
