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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-202 is amended to read as follows:	
20	20-13-202. Definitions.	
21	As used in this subchapter:	
22	(1) "Air ambulance" means an aircraft, fixed or rotary wing,	
23	utilized for on-scene responses or transports deemed necessary by a physici	.an
24	and licensed by the Department of Health;	
25	(2) "Air ambulance services" means those services authorized a	.nd
26	licensed by the department to provide care and air transportation of	
27	patients;	
28	(3) "Ambulance" means a vehicle used for transporting any pers	on
29	by stretcher or gurney upon the streets or highways of Arkansas, excluding	
30	vehicles intended solely for personal use by immediate family members;	
31	(4) "Ambulance services" means those services authorized and	
32	licensed by the department to provide care and transportation of patients	
33	upon the streets and highways of Arkansas;	
34	(5) "Board" means the State Board of Health;	
35	(6) "Gouncil" means the Emergency Medical Services Advisory	
36	Council;	

1	(7)(5) "Emergency medical services" means:
2	(A) The transportation and medical care provided the ill
3	or injured before arrival at a medical facility by a licensed emergency
4	medical services personnel or other health care provider; and
5	(B) Continuation of the initial emergency care within a
6	medical facility subject to the approval of the medical staff and governing
7	board of that facility; and
8	(C) Comprehensive integrated medical care in emergency and
9	nonurgent settings with the oversight of a physician;
10	$\frac{(8)(A)}{(6)(A)}$ "Emergency medical services personnel" means an
11	individual licensed by the department at any level established by the rules
12	adopted by the board State Board of Health under this subchapter and
13	authorized to perform those services set forth in the rules.
14	(B) These shall include without limitation EMT, Advanced
15	EMT, Paramedic, EMS Instructor, or EMS Instructor Trainer;
16	(9)(7) "Licensure" means official acknowledgment by the
17	department that an individual has demonstrated competence to perform the
18	emergency medical services required for licensure under the rules,
19	regulations, and standards adopted by the board upon recommendation by the
20	Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council; and
21	$\frac{(10)(8)}{(8)}$ "Medical facility" means any hospital, medical clinic,
22	physician's office, nursing home, or other health care facility.
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24	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 13, is amended to add an
25	additional subchapter to read as follows:
26	<u>Subchapter 16 - Community Paramedics</u>
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28	20-13-1601. Definition.
29	As used in this subchapter, "Community Paramedic" means an individual
30	who:
31	(1) Is licensed as a paramedic;
32	(2) Meets the requirements for additional licensure as a
33	community paramedic under this subchapter; and
34	(3) Provides services to patients not qualified for home health
35	services or who are qualified but have rejected home health services.
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1	20-13-1602. Community Paramedic - Licensure - Services.
2	(a) To be eligible for licensure by the Department of Health under the
3	Section of Emergency Medical Services as a Community Paramedic, an individual
4	shall:
5	(1)(A) Be currently licensed as a paramedic;
6	(B) Have two (2) years of full-time service as a
7	paramedic; and
8	(C) Be actively employed by a licensed paramedic ambulance
9	service; and
10	(2) Successfully complete a community paramedic training program
11	from a training institute approved by the Department of Health under the
12	Section of Emergency Medical Services.
13	(b) The training program for the Community Paramedic shall consist of
14	a minimum of three hundred (300) hours of classroom and clinical education as
15	follows:
16	(1) Clinical experience that is provided under the supervision
17	of a community paramedic service medical director, advanced practice
18	registered nurse, physician assistant, or public health nurse; and
19	(2) Areas of clinical experience including at a minimum:
20	(A) Emergency department services;
21	(B) Home health services;
22	(C) Hospital case management; and
23	(D) Public health agencies services.
24	(c) A community paramedic may provide services as directed by a
25	patient care plan if the plan has been developed, approved, or both by the
26	patient's primary physician, an advanced practice registered nurse, or a
27	physician assistant in conjunction with the community paramedic service's
28	medical director and relevant local health care providers.
29	(d) For purposes of relicensure a Community Paramedic shall:
30	(1) Complete an additional fifteen (15) hours training beyond
31	the relicensure requirements as a paramedic; and
32	(2) Be active in performing the skills of a Community Paramedic.
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34	20-13-1603 Rules.
35	(a) The Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council and the State
36	Roard of Health shall adopt rules to implement this subchapter.

1	(b) The rules shall consider quality assurance and adequate data
