27	WHEREAS, families are empowered to direct the education of their
28	children by choosing the best educational environment available; and

30	WHEREAS, every child has unique abilities and challenges that impact
31	how he or she learns, and every child has unique interests, passions, and
32	goals for his or her future as an adult; and

34	WHEREAS, there are multiple methods available to teach children, and
35	home schooling as a system has profound flexibility in how education is
36	delivered, as the system can be customized and individualized to the student;
