8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES
9 ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING WIRELESS CONNECTIVITY
10 TO ALL AREAS ON THE SECOND, THIRD AND FOURTH
11 FLOORS SOUTH OF THE ROTUNDA IN THE STATE CAPITOL
12 BUILDING FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE WHICH SHALL
13 BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
14 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1098 OF 2011; AND FOR OTHER
15 PURPOSES.

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18 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
19 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - WIRELESS CONNECTIVITY. There is hereby
26 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central
27 Services Fund, for equipment, software and installation necessary to provide
28 wireless connectivity in all areas on the second, third and fourth floors of
29 the State Capitol Building south of the Rotunda which shall be supplemental
30 and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1098 of 2011,

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7 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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17 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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26 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

27 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of

28 the Secretary of State are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for

29 the Secretary of State to continue to provide essential governmental

30 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies

31 for the Secretary of State to continue such services; and that a delay in the

32 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper

33 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,

34 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the

35 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in

36 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
