## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE GAME AND  
15 FISH COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
16 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the

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16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
 17 State Game and Fish Commission for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the following  
 18 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 19 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred  
 20 eighty-five (185) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 21 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 22 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 23 classification.

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25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 26 to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game  
 27 Protection Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas  
 28 State Game and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the  
 29 following:

 13 appropriated, to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable  
 14 from the Game Protection Fund, for operating expenses, capital projects,  
 15 acquisition of land and conservation easements, and grants of the Arkansas  
 16 State Game and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the

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30 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CONSERVATION PARTNERS PROGRAM GRANTS. There  
 31 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be  
 32 payable from the Game Protection Fund, for grants to conservation partners,  
 33 or other eligible entities for operating, equipment, and maintenance expenses  
 34 associated with addressing statewide hunger needs of the Arkansas State Game  
 35 and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the following:

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - BLACK RIVER SETTLEMENT FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game Protection Fund, for all expenses associated with the mitigation to the hardwood timber destruction in the Wildlife Management Area, inclusive of Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching of the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the following:

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - FERAL HOG ERADICATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game Protection Fund, for personal services, operating expenses and grants for the eradication efforts of feral hogs of the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the following:

SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT OF REWARDS. Payment of rewards shall be from the Game Protection Fund from the Commission's Maintenance and General Operation appropriation as herein appropriated in the Operating Expenses line item of the Operations appropriation.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~ 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
2 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
3 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
4 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line  
5 item authorized in the Operations appropriation to any other line item  
6 authorized in the Operations appropriation and the Agency is authorized to  
7 transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in the Gas Lease  
8 Revenues appropriation to any other line item authorized in the same section.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019  
10 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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12 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

14 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission is hereby  
15 authorized to purchase from the Maintenance & General Operation  
16 Classifications in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act for  
17 promotional items in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars  
18 (\$50,000), as authorized by the Director of the Commission to meet fish and  
19 wildlife conservations and education needs.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019  
21 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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23 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
33 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
34 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of  
36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
2 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm  
3 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
4 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
5 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
6 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.

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
